

Gobolondlo Mountain Drive (A panoramic Feast)

Let us take you to the most stunning mountain scenery in the northern part of Swaziland. Enjoy this from a viewpoint at the base of the Gobolondlo Mountain or take the twenty minutes climb and be rewarded with a 360° panorama. The Lomati, Sheshawane and Shelangubo rivers that traverse the Makhonjwa Hills and the Sondeza Mountain ranges, creating spectacular gorges. To the west the Bulembu Mountain towers over the



Bulembu Village and forestry plantations, soaring to an impressive 1862 metres above sea level, the highest Mountain in the Kingdom. Cast your eyes to the south of Bulembu into the majestic Malolotja Mountain reserve and meet the Ngwenya Mountain, 1828m above sea level.

This trip is a treasure trove for the landscape photographer and landscape artists, with views extending down to the lowveld where the Mnjoli and Sand River Dams glimmer in the distance against the Lubombo Range in the background. To the north the Ntfontjeni valley sprawls beneath you displaying Swazi homestead life and

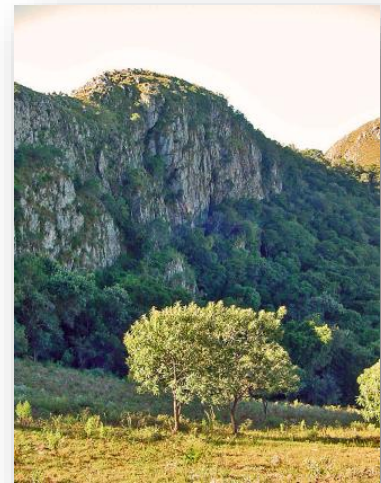
across the border to South Africa Lake Matsamo soothes the eye.



The geologically inclined will marvel at the lichen covered rock formations.

What to bring:

- Camera
- Warm sweater or jacket

- December to March: 4.00pm
